ACCESS FOR UNDERSERVED POPULATIONS

The goal of the Access to Care Project is to increase access to quality genetics services for individuals in underserved communities.

PLAIN COMMUNITIES WORKGROUP

The Plain Communities Workgroup partners with public health and genetics providers to engage individuals living in Plain Communities who experience a higher prevalence of genetic conditions.

MEDICAL INTERPRETER TRAININGS

The Midwest Genetics Network (MGN) collaborates with other regional genetics networks and national partners to develop and implement trainings in genetics for Medical Interpreters working with individuals with English as a Second Language

INDIVIDUALS LOST TO FOLLOW-UP

MGN will pilot a project to locate patients with PKU who have been lost to care and connect them with services. The model will then be adapted for use in other states.
