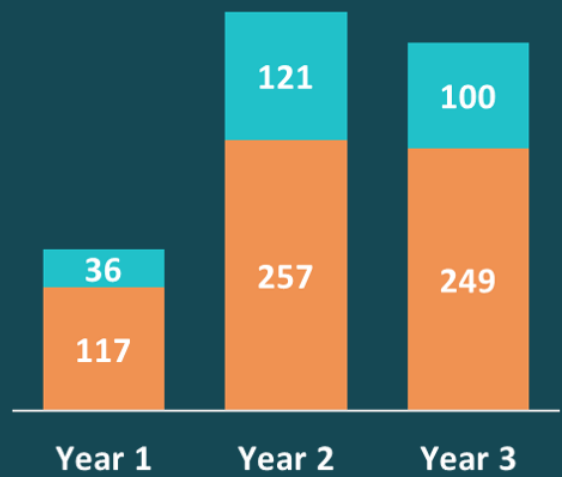

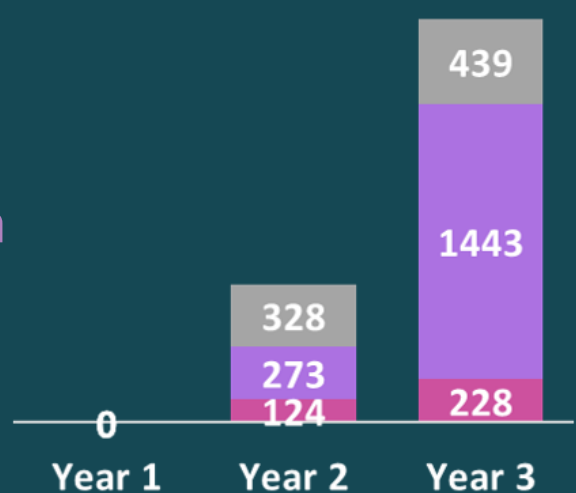

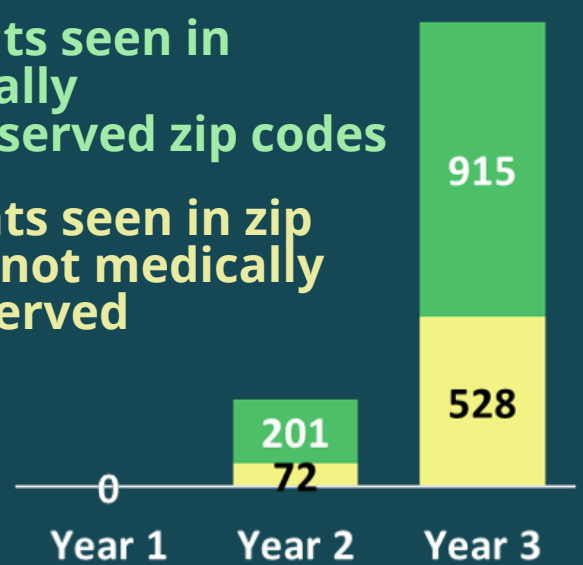


Connecting with underserved patients throughout the Midwest
